A RESOLUTION OF THE RIVERDALE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT BY THE RIVERDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM.
