

City Manager E. Scott Wood announced that the Luncheon for the Masons and the Christmas tree Lighting event was well attended.

Council Questions:

Council Member Ruffin asked who the City was working with regarding the additional cost for a left turn signal at the intersection of state road 85. Mr. Wood responded that the City was working on with the Department of Transportation. He also noted that Council Member Davis had previously inquired about a left turn signal at Roberts Drive. Mr. Wood also stated that there were concerns about adding a no left turn signal at Camp and king Road. However; there were concerns that we would have to acquire some additional right-of-way. Mr. Wood explained that the City would work with staff engineers at the Department of Transportation if the City decided to move forward with this project. He also stated that there would be incurred cost for traffic design studies. Mr. Wood noted that the cost for the traffic design would be paid to a private company.
