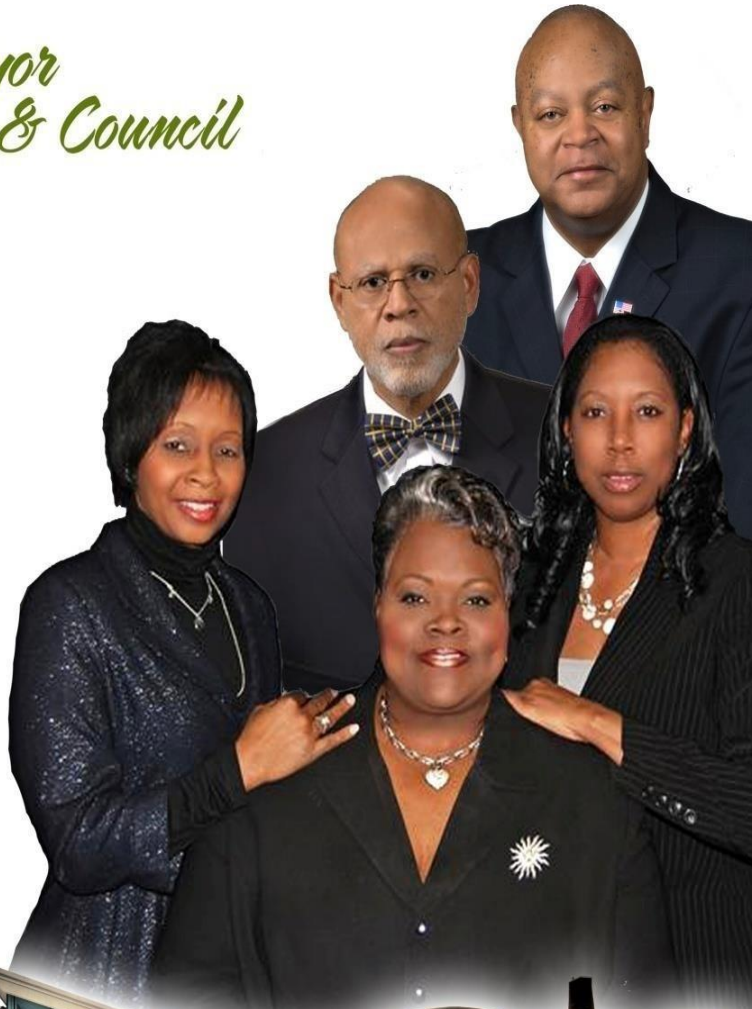

5. CITY MANAGER’S REPORT: E. SCOTT WOOD

City Manager E. Scott Wood spoke about the following items:

- Keep Riverdale Beautiful received a grant from Wal-Mart in the amount of \$2,500.

Mr. Wood stated that the funds will be used for the “Canvas on the Curb” Mural.
