



Mayor and Council Meeting Work Session Minutes February 27, 2012 6PM

The Riverdale Mayor and City Council met on February 27, 2012 at 6:00PM for the purpose of conducting a regular work session. The meeting was held in the conference room on the second floor at City Hall, located at 7200 Church Street, Riverdale, Georgia 30274.

Call to Order and Welcome

With a quorum present, Mayor Evelyn Wynn-Dixon called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

City Manager's Report

Discussion of Upcoming Audit

City Manager, Mrs. Iris Jessie, acknowledged Mayor/Council for attending the recent retreat. She advised that there would be an extended work session at a later date to discuss the uncovered topics of the retreat.

Mrs. Jessie opened the floor to Meredith Lipson, of *Mauldin Jenkins*. Ms. Jenkins advised that the opinion of the unqualified report is a satisfactory response. There were no remarks by Mayor/Council, with the exception of Councilmember Stamps-Jones.

Ms. Lipson explained the function of the recommendation of accounts for sanitation deposits. Ms. Lolita Grant, Director of Finance, advised that a tracking system would be in place to delineate payees' payments and deposits.

Councilmember Davis advised that as parliamentarian, he would be enforcing time management in meetings.

Councilmember Wallace inquired of Councilmember Ruffin the possibility of a summer basketball camp. Councilmember Ruffin advised that the turnout during the spring basketball camp would determine the necessity of hosting a camp in the summer.

There was an ensuing discussion on the various sports programs.
