



**RIVERDALE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING  
OFFICIAL COUNCIL WORK SESSION  
OCTOBER 22, 2012 6PM**

The Riverdale Mayor and City Council met on October 22, 2012 at 6:09PM for the purpose of conducting a regular work session. The meeting was held in the conference room on the second floor at City Hall, located at 7200 Church Street, Riverdale, Georgia 30274.
