CITY OF RIVERDALE'S LCI PROJECT IS DEVELOPING CITY CENTER

The City of Riverdale is hosting a public open house that will display the draft recommendations for the 2023 Livable Centers Initiative (LCI)- "Developing City Center". This grant program was created by the Atlanta Regional Commission to incentivize local jurisdictions to re-envision their communities as vibrant, walkable places that offer more mobility options, encourage healthy lifestyles, and provide better access to jobs and services. The planning team's recommendations were driven by the community's needs around housing, economic development, and connectivity to achieve this goal. The recommendations are focused within the two key study areas for the project: the greater Riverdale Core and the corridor between Church Street and Powers Street.

The public is welcome to join the planning team at the drop-in style Draft Open House on Thursday, September 7th from 12-6pm in the main atrium of Town Center (7210 Church St, Riverdale, GA 30274). There, the community will be able to learn more about the recommendations and share their feedback on what they would like to see in the study areas. This event will not have a formal presentation similar to previous public meetings for the LCI. The presentation boards will be on display with members of the planning team and residents can view the material at their leisure.
